

## NCHA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CONFERENCE CALL MINUTES DECEMBER 17, 2020 9:00AM Central

A conference call of the Executive Committee of the National Cutting Horse Association was held on Thursday, December 17, 2020 at 9:00AM central time.

NCHA Executive Director Jay Winborn, Director of Shows Shianne Megel, NCHA Comptroller Nanci Gates and Cathy Marie Aleff were also in attendance for this call.

The Executive Committee conference call was called to order by President Steve Norris at 9:02AM and roll call was taken.

### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

### 2021 SUPER STAKES

After much discussion, a suggestion was made to shift the payment dates for the 2021 Super Stakes with the first payment scheduled to be due on February 15<sup>th</sup> and second payment due on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Consensus from the Executive Committee was that they were in favor of the suggested change and approved staff implementation.

# **DRAWING ON LINE OF CREDIT**

NCHA Comptroller Nanci Gates gave a report from a recent Finance and Audit Committee Call regarding the approval of this action.

After much discussion, an amended **MOTION** was made by Lach Perks and **SECONDED** by Kirby Smith that "following the recommendation of our finance committee as well as thoroughly reviewing cash incoming with Jay Winborn over the next 30 days (which includes the anticipated receipt of our MERP receivable, unprecedented horse sales receipts from Western Bloodstock, and the anticipated payment from our insurance claim for the 2020 Super Stakes...." I move that we approve the use of our line of credit in the short term. **MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.**
