CLASS LEVELING IMPLEMENTATION PLAN REVIEW

NCHA Chief Financial Officer Lance Bryson facilitated and gave a detailed description of an implementation plan that staff developed with all the moving parts to successfully produce a Triple Crown event with the proposed leveling structure that the Competition Committee recommended at the August EC Meeting. This implementation plan concentrated on the full scope for a produced show with recommendations from staff and that also identified any risks on financial impact.

A timeline with key target dates was suggested in order to communicate with members if perhaps this proposal is brought to a vote at the next EC meeting in October.

Suggestion was made to cross-reference the approved documents from the payout task force committee that was put in place years ago.

An overview of the West Texas Futurity which recently adopted an added money version of the proposed leveling structure was heard.

After lengthy discussions, the staff was asked to make some modifications to the implementation plan on the proposed class leveling system with regards to the payout structure for consideration during a vote.

The EC agreed with staff to issue a press release with some helpful information to educate and communicate with members on the proposed leveling system structure immediately following this call.
