1. APPROVAL FEE(S)

- a. At NCHA Challenger Shows approved by the National Cutting Horse Association (NCHA), a \$200.00 show approval fee shall be paid by Show Management and forwarded to the NCHA; this fee is to be sent along with all completed NCHA Results Forms to the Associations office (260 Bailey Ave, Fort Worth, TX 76107) immediately following the conclusion of each contest (within five (5) days).
- b. A \$3.00 per entry National Circuit Fee for all weekend approved classes will be collected from contestants by the show secretary and sent to NCHA as a separate check with show results.

NOTE: NO DEDUCTION OTHER THAN AS SPECIFIED AS ABOVE SHALL BE MADE. THIS APPROVAL FEE AND THE NATIONAL CIRCUIT FEE MAY NOT BE DEDUCTED FROM THE ENTRY FEE OR PAYOUT TO THE CONTESTANTS. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL CAUSE APPROVAL OF THE SHOW TO BE WITHDRAWN.

2. PARITY OF PURSES

- a. Parity of Purses is not required. Any class can be jackpot or may offer \$1 to \$199 in added money
- b. Classes (DO NOT HAVE TO OFFER OPEN/NON-PRO) offered and schedule up to show management.

3. JUDGE(S)

- a. NO ADDED MONEY: Approved judge recommended but not mandatory, approved judges will receive credit.
 - i. If unapproved judge is used, he/she must be a member in good standing for the last three (3) years, of not, results will not be processed.
- b. ADDED MONEY: Approved judge is mandatory.
- c. In the case that multiple judges are used, JUDGES MAY NOT JUDGE EACH OTHER.
- d. Judge protest system in not in place.
- e. Approved judge must be named seven (7) days before show start date.

4. SECRETARY

- a. Approved secretary is recommended, but not mandatory.
- b. If an unapproved secretary is used, he/she must be a current member in good standing.

5. VIDEOGRAPHY

- a. Video is mandatory.
- b. Any standard video equipment is acceptable with reasonable video and audio clarity. Show must keep the video for 180 days in the case that it is needed by NCHA. Producers do not have to duplicate the video for the weekend monitor system.

6. RESULTS

a. Results of all classes (NCHA approved and unapproved) held within a NCHA Challenger Show must be submitted via NCHA Results Forms to the Associations office (260 Bailey Ave, Fort Worth, TX 76107) immediately following the conclusion of each contest (within five (5) days).

7. YOUTH

a. Youth must meet NCHA criteria.

Further, show management agrees to indemnify and hold NCHA harmless from and all Liability, of any, arising to NCHA by virtue of it granting us show approval, and if NCHA is sued in court of law, to defend it at our expense, and if judgment is taken against NCHA, to pay said judgment and obtain written release in form acceptable to NCHA.
