What is a NYCHA Senior Youth Regional Director

The NYCHA Senior Regional Directors consisting of one representative in each of the eight regions.

The Senior Regional Directors and the Senior Officers will make up the Senior Board of Directors. The Senior Regional Directors will work closely with Senior Officers to help grow the NYCHA to a level of excellence, work with the Area Directors on item to strengthen the NYCHA membership, to help Area Directors with scholarship and grant opportunities, establishing education and leadership programs, fund raisers and any other projects to continue the excitement of the NYCHA.

Want to become a NYCHA Senior Youth Regional Director?

NYCHA Senior Youth Regional Directors will serve one-year terms. A member applying for a regional director position must be an eligible youth member in the year they will serve. They must be at least age 14 as of June 1st, the prior year to the term they will serve. The term of service will be from the end of Youth Convention Week, July to the end of the following Youth Convention Week, July.

What are the responsibilities of a NYCHA Senior Youth Regional Director?

- Attending NYCHA meetings to represent your regions relating to NYCHA activities. Meetings of the Youth Board of Directors will be conducted with a conference call or in person if possible.
- Communicate all NYCHA Youth Area Directors about ongoing matters involving the NYCHA
- Assist in coordinating with NYCHA Youth Area Directors all fundraisers to include but not limited to the Stallion Service Program and/or raffles.
- Submit at least one article for the monthly Youth Newsletter and/or Youth Connection in the Chatter.
- Assist in recruiting new youth members
- Assist NYCHA Youth Area Directors with educational and leadership programs in their area.
- Assist with developing scholarship and grant opportunities.
- Conduct any other business that the NYCHA Youth President deems necessary.
