Amateur Committee Mission Statement

1. Recommend the rules governing those who hold an NCHA Amateur card.

2. Make recommendations regarding Amateur classes held at Limited Age Events and Weekend Shows.

3. Make recommendations regarding rules for determining and maintaining Amateur eligibility.

4. Make recommendations on new ideas that will encourage participation and growth of the Amateur division.

FAMILY HORSE RULE

STANDING RULE 51.a.4. If a member who holds an NCHA Non-Professional and/or Amateur card publicly exhibits in any contest, whether approved or unapproved, a cutting horse not owned by the member or by the member's Immediate Family as defined herein, the member will be subject to disciplinary actions as provided in this rule, in addition to potential disciplinary actions under Rule 50.d.4.

For purposes of this rule "Immediate Family" shall mean the member's spouse. child, stepchild, parent, grandparents, grandchild step-parent, sibling, halfsibling, step-sibling, spouse's parent, spouse's step-parent, sibling's spouse. half-sibling's spouse, step sibling's spouse, sibling's child, sibling's step-child, half-sibling' child, half-sibling's step-child, step-sibling's child, step-sibling's step-child, parent's sibling, parent's half-sibling, parent's step-sibling, parent's sibling's child, parent's sibling's stepchild, parent' half sibling's child, parent's half sibling's stepchild, parent's step sibling's child, parent's step sibling's stepchild, legal ward or legal guardian. Any member who owns a horse that he/she wants his or her immediate family to show pursuant to this rule is responsible for completing the forms prescribed by the NCHA relating to a family-owned horse and filing those forms with the NCHA prior to the show in which any qualified family member will show that horse. The horse owner member is also responsible for updating their family-owned horse information with the NCHA to be sure it is accurate and up to date A member showing a horse owned by an immediate family member under this rule may have his or her entry fees and expenses paid by an immediate family member.

Penalties for ownership rule violations may include immediate loss of Non-Professional/Amateur status of the member, up to three (3) years suspension from the NCHA, up to a maximum of \$10,000 fi ne. Also, any other member found guilty of aiding and abetting the rule violator will be subject to the same penalties depending on the severity of the incident.

Time starts counting when the rider won their first \$1. So if they were members in 2022 but didn't win a \$1 until 2023, time to win out starts with 2023 point year.

Notes on population inclusion:

-\$15K Amateur / \$50K Amateur riders for the dividions is the population of all Amateur riders.

-\$35K Non Pro Riders for the division includes NP and Amateur riders.

-Earned Out Rider numbers are the same between the 2 populations since those that earned out were active and earned \$1.

Observations on the \$1 Earned Group - PERCENTAGE ELIGIBLE FOR EACH CLASS

-The % eligible for the \$50K is more than 76% at the start of the year in the \$1 earned group.

-The % eligible for the \$35K is more than 67% at the start of the year in the \$1 earned group.

-The % eligible for the \$15K is more than 56% at the start of the year in the \$1 earned group.

-'The % eligible for the \$2K is the smallest at the start of the year with 34% being eligible in the \$1 earned group.

The percentage eligible varys less than 2% from year to year in the 2k, 35 and 50. Only the 15 lies outside that with 4% decrease between 2022 and 2024. The number of riders in each division increased in every class in every year. The number of eligible riders in each class decreased between 2023 and 2024 in every class.

Observations on the \$1 Earned Group - EARNING OUT

2K limit has the highest % of riders earn out at 14% (252 out of 1800 earned out in 2022) 15K amateur earn out percentages increased between 2022 and 2024 from 6.2 to 6.9% 35K NonPro earn out percentages increased beteen 2002 and 2024 from 3.6 to 4.7% 50K Amateur earn out percentaged increased between 2002 and 20024 from 3.2 to 3.5%

Population is the group of riders that started the 2022 point year with \$0 earnings but that won at least \$1 in 2022, 2023 or 2024.

15 and 50 classes only include riders with amateur status.35 class only includes riders with NP OR Amateur status.

Only 1,457 riders started with \$0 earnings in 2022.

The telling numbers are the last line: 79% of 2K riders are still in the 2K 94% of 15K riders are still in the 15. 98% of 35K riders are still in the 35 99% of 50K riders are still in the 50.

Are Amateur status and Non Pro status the same?

While all Amateurs are automatically also Non Pros, not all Non Pros are eligible to be Amateurs. Non Pro status has fewer restrictions. Amateurs have all of the restrictions of Non Pro PLUS a few more.

Non Pros AND Amateurs CAN:

- Share expenses while hauling, i.e., gas, lodging, food, etc.
- Accept a horse as a gift from anyone provided there is no pre-arranged agreement to return the horse to its prior owner, as long as it is reported to NCHA.
- Buy a horse based on installment payments, provided a fixed amount is stated and paid. A copy of the written sales agreement must be provided to NCHA and needs to state the name of the horse, the sale price, payment dates, amounts and the date of final payment.
- Receive compensation for judging cutting horse contests and other horse show classes.
- Board horses in their barn and provide cattle for training as long as they do NOT work any boarders' horses on cattle in any arena, pen or pasture, or on a cutting device.
- Endorse products publicly as long as they receive no remuneration, pay all of their own expenses and keep any logo(s) modest.
- Win monies by showing as long as all winnings are returned to the individual Non- Pro/Amateur who competed on the horse.
- Show a horse owned by a corporation, business or partnership as long as they and/or family members are the owner.

Amateurs **CAN NOT** do or have done all of the below Non-Pro section PLUS:

- Have EVER ridden or trained horses or riders in any discipline astride for remuneration of any kind.
- Have assisted in training horses or riders in any discipline astride for remuneration of any kind.
- Have been an apprentice trainer at any time in any discipline.
- Be married or have been married to or lived with a professional trainer in any discipline.
- Have lived or currently live on the premises of a training operation.
- Have lived or currently live with a person who is classified as a trainer in any discipline.
- Have been directly or indirectly employed by a professional trainer or work at a horse training operation of any kind.
- Have any portion of their expenses paid by another party, except under the family rule.
- Ride horses they or an immediate family member do not own in competition unless it is:
 - In RIDER classes with earnings limit \$2,000 or less or Youth class.

Non-Pros CAN NOT:

- Be a Hall of Fame trainer in any discipline.
- Show, train or assist in training cutting horses or cutting horse riders under any circumstance or in any capacity
 - For remuneration (pay).
 - In exchange for any goods or services (i.e., rent, cattle use, veterinary bills, transportation expenses or entry fees for self or horse, etc.).
- Show, train or assist in training horses astride in any cattle/cow horse equine discipline for direct or indirect remuneration.
- Have been an apprentice cutting horse trainer.
- Transfer a horse to another person for the sole purpose of sharing expenses.
- Have any portion of their expenses paid by another party, except under the family rule.
- Ride horses they or an immediate family member do not own in competition unless it is:
 In RIDER classes with earnings limit \$2,000 or less or Youth class.

EXCEPTIONS

NCHA Rules contain several exception rules that may allow a member to obtain Non-Pro or Amateur status under certain limited circumstances. Please consult the NCHA rules for the details of these exception rules. If you believe that you may qualify for Non-Pro or Amateur status under one of these exception rules and would like to apply, please contact the NCHA office to obtain an application form for the exception that you are seeking.
