

Veterinarians Practice Policy

ATTENTION: ALL VETERINARIANS THAT PRACTICE AT NCHA PRODUCED EVENTS. All practicing Veterinarians (VETS) on show grounds will be required to be a <u>NCHA MEMBER</u> and sign an <u>APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO TREAT HORSES ON NCHA SHOW GROUNDS AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF NCHA RULES AGREEMENT</u> to practice on grounds at NCHA produced events.

- Vet agreement and membership holds vets to same rules and due process as members
- Requires vet to become familiar and bound to NCHA medication rules.
- NCHA Membership will be free for veterinarians that do not show or own NCHA horses.
- All veterinarians are required to complete and submit a membership application along with the signed copy of the Agreement.
