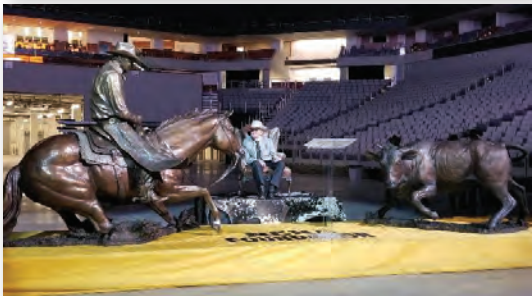
I would like to end on that note and wish everyone good luck in the rest of this hauling year!

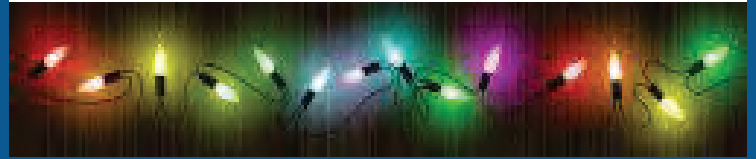

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN AREA 15

Although the show season has slowed down for Area 15, we are working to create a 2020 schedule that presents as few conflicts as possible for our members after a year full of news related to our youth. One of our most recent events to promote the NYCHA was held at Quarter Horse Congress in Columbus, Ohio. Lance Bryson, our NCHA CFO, and myself discussed the leadership opportunities that NCHA provides to our youth, such as becoming an area director, while everyone enjoyed lunch from Fire N the Hole Wood Fired Pizza. In addition to ways youth can get involved in our organization, we explained the benefits of LEAP points. Zoe Woodland, a trainer in Ohio who was an active youth and teaches many young cutters today, also came in to emphasize the opportunities NCHA offers that grant leadership skills while having fun showing an amazing athlete. This event was open to both NCHA youth and youth from other disciplines. We found it to be successful since many youth and their parents attended and now that we have raised awareness of what NCHA can do for the futures of our sport, some are already looking forward to applying for the Area 15 Director position as well as tracking LEAP points.

While at Congress, I also held my drawing for a free breeding to the proven NCHA stallion A Tale Of The Cat. The partners on A Tale Of The Cat allowed me to raise money for GLCHA youth programs, such as scholarships, through a raffle for a free 2020 breeding. Many of Michigan's youth are from Ohio and Indiana, so this raffle will benefit our entire area and I cannot thank "Torch's" partners enough.

Also be on the lookout for a Youth Scholarship Cutting at the 2020 Congress as we are currently in the early stages of planning this event.
