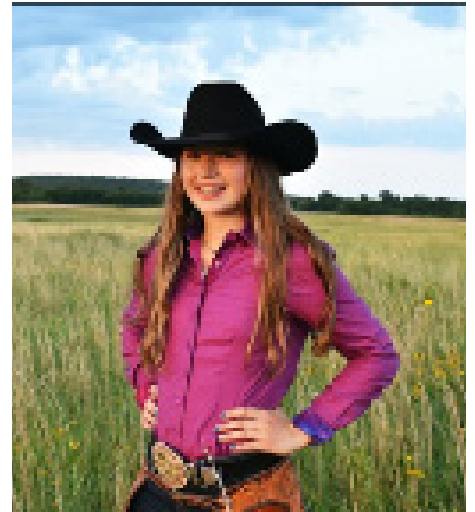
SENIOR REPORTER'S UPDATE
